



## **CALL FOR POEMS, SPOKEN WORD AND SONGS**

## THEME: NATIONAL VALUES AND PRINCIPLES OF GOVERNANCE

The Kenya Institute for Public Policy Research and Analysis (KIPPRA), in collaboration with Jaramogi Oginga Odinga University of Science and Technology (JOOUST), has organized a research and public policy workshop which will take place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> of December 2021, under KIPPRA flagship programme called KIPPRA Mentorship Programme for Universities (KMPUs). The programme seeks to mentor university students and lecturers for effective participation in the public policy formulation, research, policy analysis, and debate. The event brings together university students, lecturers, government, and private sector. One of the key activities during the event will be to sensitize university students, lecturers, government, and private sector participants on Article 10 of the Constitution on 'National Values and Principles of Governance".

This is a call for interested students at JOOUST and participating universities within the Lake Region Economic Bloc to submit poems, spoken word and songs that speak to Article 10 of the Constitution, on the 17 national values and principles of governance, for consideration. The entries will be evaluated, and the top performances will be selected for presentation during the event.

The entries should meet the following criteria:

- 1. Include **full name**, **university**, **school/department**, **registration number**, **email**, and **mobile phone number** of the presenter(s).
- 2. Not exceeding **3 minutes video clip**.
- **3.** A student will submit one video clip **only.**
- 4. Submissions **MUST** indicate the word **JOOUST TALENT MANAGEMENT** on the email subject line.

**The deadline for submission** of the essays is **Friday 16**<sup>th</sup> **November 2021**, after which they will undergo a review process and successful entries will be notified by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> December 2021.
