Mainstreaming Planning and Budgeting for the Agriculture Sector Training

Introduction

KIPPRA is a public think tank with the mandate of developing capacities for policy formulation, implementation and evaluation within National and County governments; undertaking relevant and timely policy research and analysis; serve as a point of policy engagement and communication on public policy; and developing and maintaining a reservoir of knowledge on public policy in contributing to the achievement of national development goals.

As such, one of focal areas of interest in public policy research and capacity building is the Agriculture Sector. Agriculture contributes more than a third of the country's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) yet food and nutrition security continues to be a challenge. There is need, to systematically analyses the spending in the sector, to provide evidence required to inform the budgetary process. The indicators of agriculture public expenditures provide a means to track the level and composition of expenditures in support of the sector. This makes it easy to identify priority areas, investment needs, and ensure consistency with government policy objectives.

It is against this backdrop that KIPPRA has designed the Mainstreaming Planning and Budgeting for the Agriculture Sector Training. The training aims to facilitate the mainstream of the Comprehensive Africa Agriculture Development Programme (CAADP), an initiative of the African Union Commission which focuses on improving food and nutrition security and increasing incomes in Africa's largely farming-based economies. This is by raising agricultural productivity and increasing public investment in agriculture.

Mode of delivery

The training programme takes five (5) days of intensive learning and practicals.

Learning outcomes

At the end of the mainstreaming planning and budgeting for the Agriculture sector training, participants are expected demonstrate the following learning outcomes: -

1. Have an overview of the various policies in the Agriculture Sector
2. Understand the importance of investing in the Agriculture Sector
3. Demonstrate understanding of the public expenditure indicators
4. Measure public expenditure in the Agriculture sector at National and County levels
5. Understand how public expenditure and reporting impacts programmes in the Agriculture Sector
6. Apply skills and knowledge acquired to come up with priority areas for investment in the Agriculture Sector

Facilitation

This course will be facilitated by KIPPRA trainers using a learner-based approach to achieve global best practices in adult learning.

Who should participate?

The training program targets policy makers, policy analysts and implementers (in both national and county government and the private sector), bureaucrats and other related professionals.

Training sessions

The training will be carried out in four modules namely:

1. Rationale for investing in the Agriculture Sector
2. Key concepts in public expenditure analysis
3. Sources of data and data management
4. Measuring and analyzing public expenditures
