Preamble

We, the participants at the 5th KIPPRA Annual Regional Conference held at the Kenya School of Government, Nairobi on 15th to 17th June 2022, express our gratitude and appreciation to all the partners who supported KIPPRA in organizing a successful conference. The conference brought together State and non-State actors to exchange views towards building robust foundations to accelerate economic transformation in Kenya. This is in line with the Institute's mandate of providing a platform for public policy dialogue.

We acknowledge the importance of strong foundations in propelling the transformation of Kenya's economy and in achieving the aspirations of the Kenya Vision 2030. In the last two years, the country has experienced three exogenous shocks, whose effects continue to be felt. These are the COVID-19 pandemic, a prolonged drought condition, and the Russia-Ukraine war. These shocks have emphasized the need for economic transformation for strong inclusive and sustainable development. As the economy continues to recover, solidifying our economic foundations has become a priority to sustain the transformation momentum.

The key areas of discussion in the conference were categorized into eight subthemes, namely: Macroeconomic status; Human capital in transformation process, Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC), Technical Vocational Education and Training (TVET) and Special Needs Education; Values and economic transformation; Green economy, clean energy, wetlands, waste management and youth in climate change action; Gig economy and digital innovation; Creative economy in transformation process; Trade competitiveness; Financial inclusion, fintech, and affirmative finance; and
